Concentration and Application Methods

Boat and Hull Cleaning

Dilute 2-4 oz. of Boat & Hull Cleaner per gallon of cleaning water (increase concentration, if needed). Brush, spray, or roller on dilute solution of Boat & Hull Cleaner to exterior of boat. Scrub heavily soiled areas. Rinse off with fresh water. Repeat application if necessary.
