For cold temperatures as low as -5°F or heavy-duty cleaning, use 919 at full strength. To clean windows and mirrors, porcelain and most cleaning jobs in warm temperatures dilute 919 with up to 8 parts of water before use. For temperatures below -5°F, use Winter Windshield Wash.

#### Concentration and Application Methods

Spray 919 onto surface and wipe with a clean lint free cloth or paper towel. For the best streak free performance, turn towel to a clean surface frequently. Polish dry with a clean paper towel.
