Concentration and Application Methods

Medium-Duty Floor Cleaning

Wet Floor with fresh water. Sprinkle PFC onto floor and directly on heavily soiled areas. Allow PFC to penetrate oil, grease, and stains for a few minutes while scrubbing heavily soiled areas with a brush or broom. Follow with a fresh water rinse to eliminate residue.

Light-Duty Floor Cleaning

Dilute 4 oz. to 16 oz. of PFC per gallon of hot water and apply using conventional methods. Rinse with fresh water to eliminate residue.
